





Derbyshire Council




- Over 5000 under 25s out of work across Derbyshire – 6.4% compared to 5.5% national average.
- Need help for young people leaving school or college to get job/create career path.
- 'One in a Million' scheme to try to encourage suppliers of goods and services to take on an apprentice

Derbyshire Council



- 500 apprenticeships within the County Council over next four years from staff turnover.
- Training grants to encourage 200 small and medium size local companies to take on an apprentice

Derbyshire County Council



- Apprenticeship Training Agency(s) to be recruited with scheme launched January 2012.
- Liaison with Job Centre Plus to provide work placements, perhaps as prelude to apprenticeships.
- Secondment of staff to organisations like the Princes Trust to support their programmes for young people
- New mentoring scheme for children in care to provide support and boost belief and confidence
