Timescale for Adult Care legislation

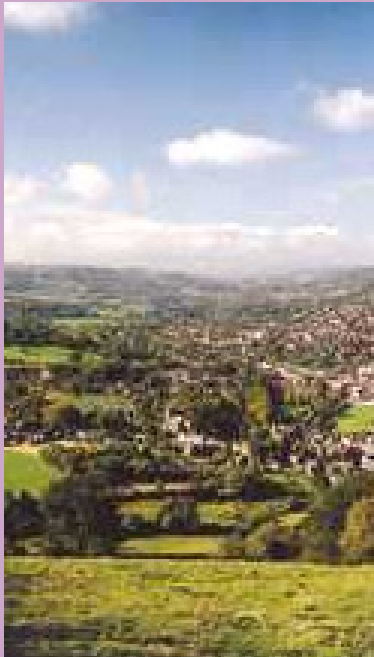

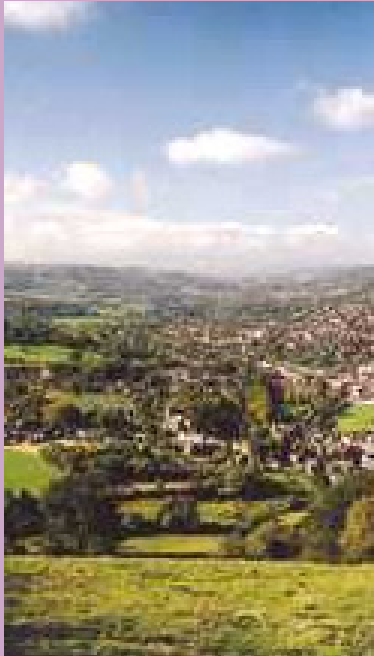
Derbyshire Adult Care priorities for the next two years

- Individuals, carers and communities involved in supporting each other and influencing the development of services



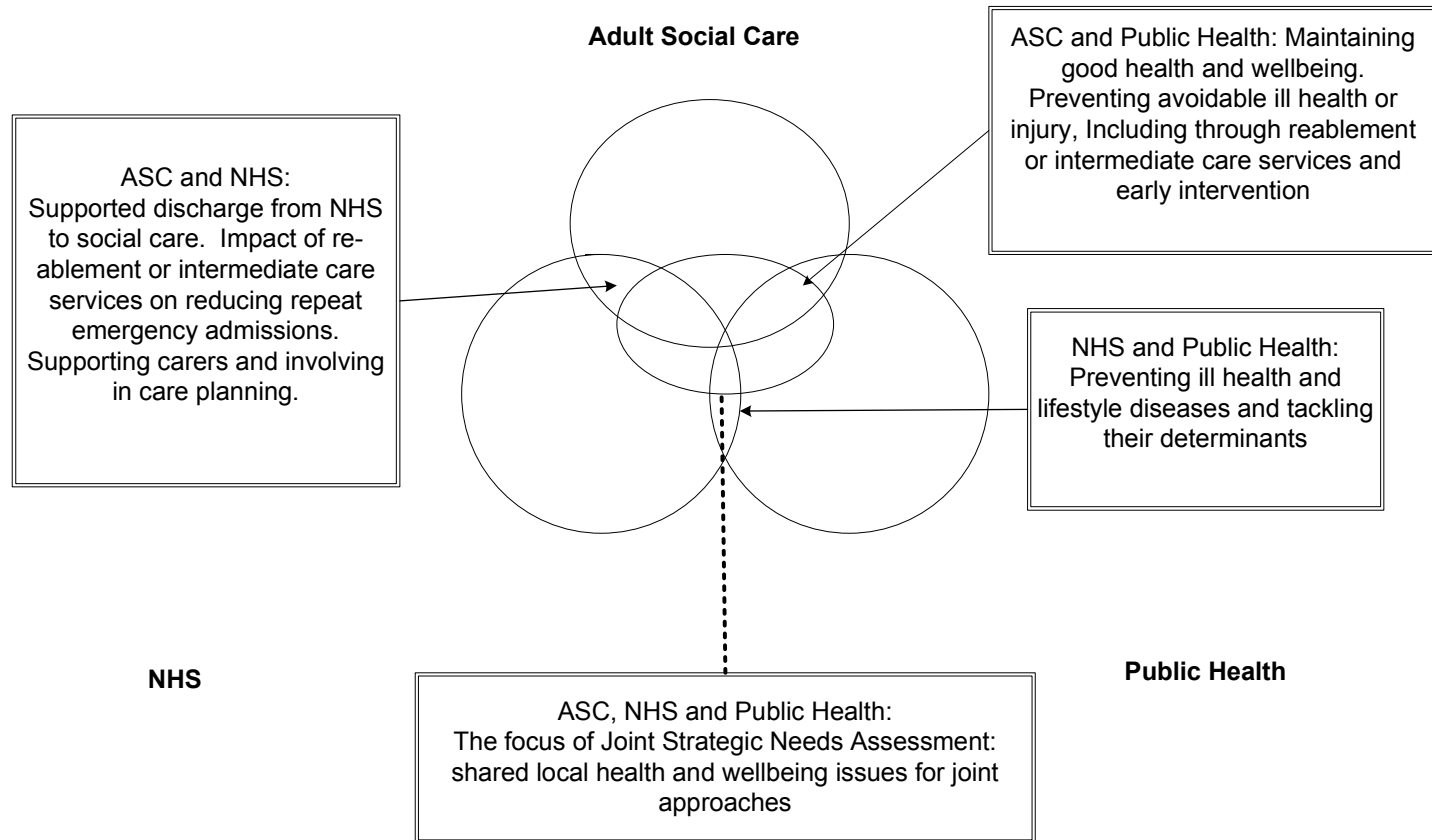
Derbyshire Adult Care priorities for the next two years

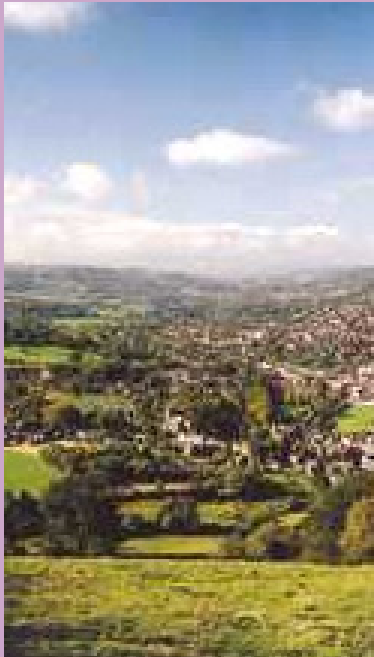
- Joint commissioning strategies, which maximise choice and control whilst balancing investment in prevention and early intervention

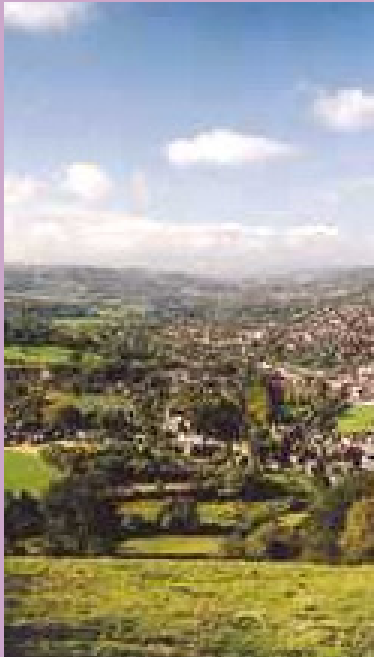

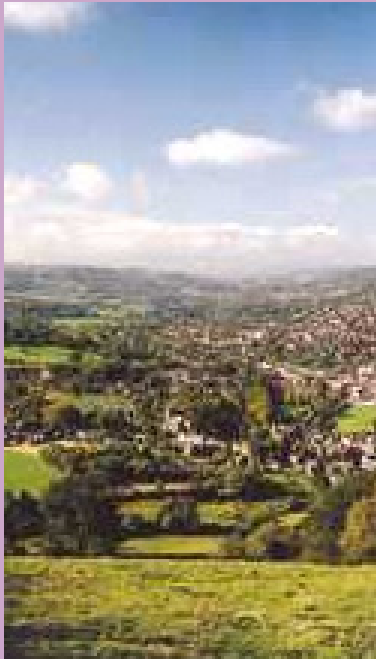
